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### **2. If you can not submit in Person:**

You may complete this form in the presence of a Notary. When you visit the Notary, bring your identity documents and a blank copy of this form:

- A valid government-issued photo ID such as a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport.
- A blank copy of your “2023-2024 Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose (To Be Signed with Notary)” form.
