How to Apply

• Complete and submit application via your student Banner. Applications are accepted year-round.

Internships

As International Sustainable Development Major, you are required to take at least 3 credits of internship relevant to your academic and career goals. Interns work in public and private sectors as well as local, national, and international non-profit organizations. Students are encouraged to complete their internship experience during their junior or senior year.

Criteria:

- An internship setting and activities performed must be in the development field but can be in a variety of organizational types.
- Your work must be overseen by an on-site supervisor.
- You must meet with your on-site supervisor periodically throughout the internship.
- Your supervisor must agree to provide ongoing formative evaluations and a formal final evaluation of your work.
- The site must provide at least five hours of experiential learning per week and at least 50 hours during the quarter for one-credit.

Credits:

The International Sustainable Development major requires a minimum of 3 internship credist; however, students may earn up to 6 credits for their internship experience. The number of credits that students are eligible to receive is directly connected to the number of hours worked at their internship site:

- 1 credit (3 5 hrs/week)
- 2 credits (6 8 hrs/week)
- 3 credits (9 11 hrs/week)
- 4 credits (12 14 hrs/week)
- 5 credits (15 20 hrs/week)
- 6 credits (20 24 hrs/week)
