This is a sample schedule of sequencing for the Communication Studies major. There is some flexibility in the first two years as you navigate general education requirements and the major's core courses. Watch years three and four closely for courses that are offered only once per year. These last two years also provide opportunities to pursue a minor or second major. In addition, keep in mind that a total of 180 credits (including 60 upper-division credits) are required to graduate.
