**Freshman Year: Thinking Historically**

HIS 1357, HIS 1490, or HIS 1734 (5 credits): WKSS course

HIS 2881: Careers in History (1 credit)

HIS 2870: Introduction to Museum Studies and Public History (5 credits): Note this course is offered every other year so students must plan accordingly.

**Sophomore Year: Systems in History**
