Classes for prospective elementary teachers are scheduled in a dedicated mathematics education classroom, designed for learning in small groups, which includes manipulative materials and an interactive whiteboard. Math majors complete a research project under faculty mentorship and joint research with undergraduates is encouraged. - Earned doctorate in Mathematics Education or closely related field.
- Excellent teacher, committed to undergraduate Mathematics Education instruction and curriculum development (both content and methods).
- Experience teaching K-12 mathematics, elementary level preferred.
