RE: Medical Insurance and Physical Exams for 2007-08

The NCAA requires all student-athletes, athletic training students, student-coaches, managers and cheerleaders to provide evidence of medical insurance that includes coverage for intercollegiate athletic-related injuries. This is a pre-requisite for any practice or competition for sports. No student will be allowed to participate in any way until such evidence of current insurance is on file with the Seattle Pacific University Department of Athletics.

SPU provides medical coverage for student-athletes in addition to the athlete's required primary insurance. However, this coverage is secondary to the student-athlete's primary coverage and claims must be processed by the student-athlete's insurance prior to review by SPU for secondary coverage.

Enclosed are the SPU Department of Athletics Medical Policies and Procedures, the Athletic Medical History Form, and Medical Insurance Questionnaire. Please review this information in its entirety.

1. Medical Policies and Procedures. This document should be reviewed now by both the parent and athlete and kept for future reference. In part, this document outlines SPU's requirements for physical exams, insurance, and processing of claims for an athletic related injury. SPU assumes no responsibility whatsoever for payment of, or authorization to pay, medical expenses resulting from injuries that occur while participating in intercollegiate athletics unless there is full compliance with these stated Medical Policies and Procedures.
2. Athletic Medical History Form. Please fill out and return this form to the Dept of Athletics by Friday, July 13. (*Must be on file before an athlete can participate in any way*). Note: This form is now required by the NCAA to be submitted annually by all athletes.
3. Medical Insurance Questionnaire. Please fill out and return this form, with corresponding copy of both sides of insurance card, to the Dept of Athletics by Friday, July 13. (*Must be on file before an athlete can participate in any way*). If you have questions regarding the terms of your insurance coverage, you should contact your insurer for clarification. Additionally, it is vital that the student-athlete has a clear understanding of their own policy coverage and the appropriate procedures required to be followed. Note that any changes in policy information during the year must be reported to the Dept of Athletics as soon as any change occurs and a new Medical Insurance Questionnaire must be filled out and on file.
4. An annual pre-participation physical is also required prior to any practice or competition.
