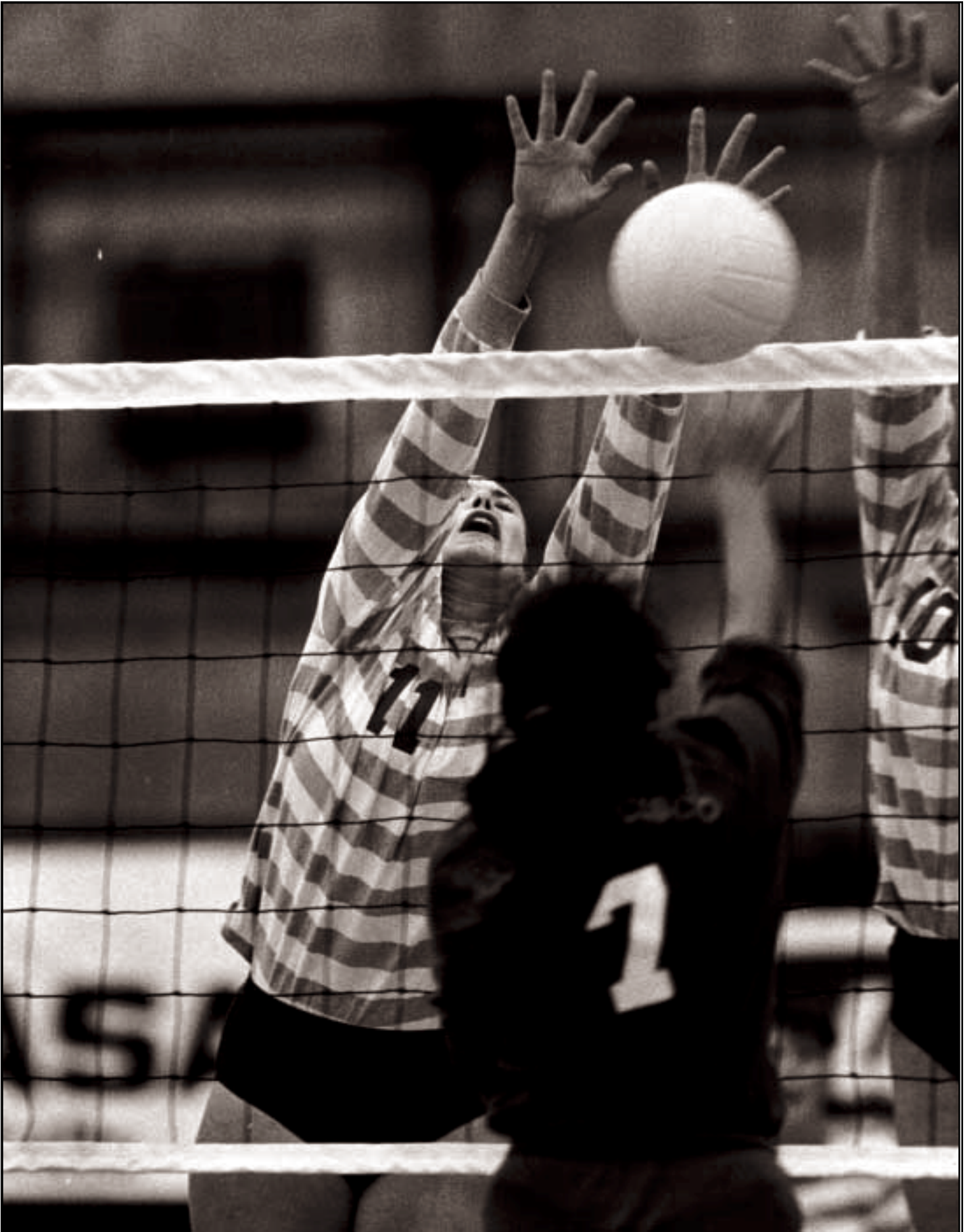

## Seattle Pacific Volleyball History

Volleyball joined Seattle Pacific University's roster of intercollegiate sports in 1986, and has emerged as a regional power over the last 10 years.

Prompted by NCAA membership criteria which requires a minimum of two men's and women's team sports, the SPU Intercollegiate Athletic Committee surveyed the students, faculty and surrounding community and volleyball was a popular choice. The decision to add volleyball was made on February 5, 1986, and former Whitworth College coach JoAnn Atwell-Scrivner was chosen to direct the program three months later.

Initially, the Falcons were playing members of the NAIA District 1, joining 10 other Northwest schools. In its first-ever match, played Sept. 16, 1986 at Brougham Pavilion, SPU swept Northwest College in three games, 15-3, 15-1, 15-12.

Despite being a fledgling program, Seattle Pacific improved rapidly and qualified for the district playoffs by the second season with a winning record. The Falcons again qualified for the district tournament in 1989 and '90, advancing as far as the semifinal round in '89.

In 1991, SPU dropped its NAIA affiliation in favor of NCAA Division II, and joined the Continental Divide Conference, the

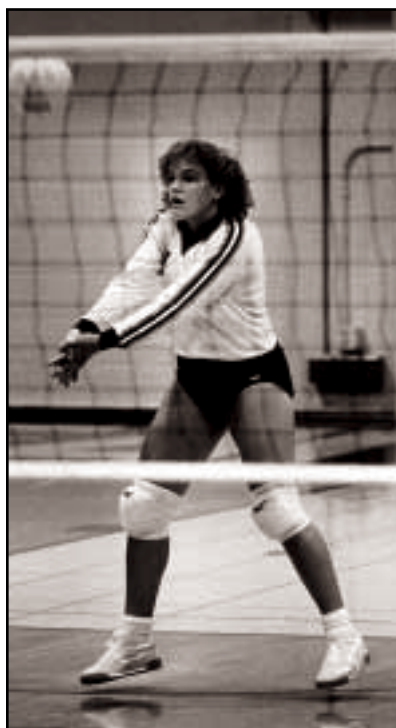
forerunner to the Pacific West Conference. In 2000, under new coach and former player Kellie Ryan, the Falcons earned their first of two NCAA postseason berths after several near-misses.

In 2005, in its first season under Chris Johnson, Seattle Pacific earned a share of its first conference championship, the first trip to the NCAA tourney in four years and a best-ever season-ending national ranking of No. 18.

## Great Northwest Athletic Conference History

The Great Northwest Athletic Conference may be relatively new, but it has quickly established itself as a formidable presence in NCAA Division II. Formed in September of 2000 and entering its fifth season of championship play in 2005, the GNAC is comprised of 10 members in four western states.

Three of the members—Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific—were charter members of the old Great Northwest Conference for men's basketball in 1982. The GNC merged with the women's Continental Divide Conference to form the Pacific West Conference in 1992. All nine GNAC members competed in the PacWest through the 2000-01 season.

Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific are longtime Division II members. Former NAIA programs Central Washington, Saint Martin's, Western Oregon and Western Washington joined in 1998 and Northwest Nazarene and Seattle U. came aboard in 1999. Montana State Billings will be added in 2007-08.

The multi-sport conference sponsors championship play in 14 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's track & field (indoor and outdoor) and women's volleyball. Men's basketball, women's basketball and women's volleyball feature full nine-team fields.

## NCAA Division II Championships

The NCAA Division II Championship tournament was initiated in 1981 with 10 teams participating in the inaugural competition. The field was expanded from 28 to 32 teams in 1997, to 48 in 2000 and grew to 64 teams in 2004, with each of the eight regions receiving eight berths.

Regional realignment in 1999 moved Seattle Pacific and the rest of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference from the Northwest into the new Pacific Region. The extremely strong (six past NCAA champions) California Collegiate Athletic Association and Pacific West Conference comprise the balance of the region.

Each of the eight NCAA regionals will feature four teams playing in the first round, with the top two seeds receiving byes through to the semifinals. Regional competition is single-elimination, best-of-five matches. The winners of the eight regionals will advance to the finals, which also will be at an on-campus site.

GNAC teams have regularly received playoff bids. While members of the PacWest, two teams—Alaska Anchorage (1989-90) and Seattle Pacific (2000)—received regional berths. The Falcons qualified in 2001 and again in 2005 as members of the GNAC.
