Great Northwest Athletic Conference History

The Great Northwest Athletic Conference is relatively new in name but already holds a prominent position within the NCAA Division II arena. Formed in September of 2000 and entering its sixth season of championship play in 2006-07, the GNAC is comprised of nine members in four western states.

Three of the members—Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific—were charter members of the old Great Northwest Conference for men's basketball in 1982. The GNC merged with the women's Continental Divide Conference to form the Pacific West Conference in 1992. All nine GNAC members competed in the PacWest through the 2000-01 season. Montana State Billings will join in 2007-08.

Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific are longtime Division II members. Former NAIA programs Central Washington, Saint Martin's, Western Oregon and Western Washington joined in 1998. Northwest Nazarene and Seattle U. came aboard in 1999.

The multi-sport conference sponsors championship play in 14 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's track & field (indoor and outdoor) and women's volleyball. Men's basketball, women's basketball and women's volleyball feature full nine-team fields.

NCAA Division II Championships

The NCAA Division II Championships tournament was initiated in 1957 with 32 teams participating in the inaugural competition. In 2003 the NCAA expanded the tournament from 48 to 64 teams. Eight teams advance to each of the eight regional tournaments, to be hosted by one of the top two seeds.

Great Northwest Athletic Conference teams have regularly received playoff bids. In 1988 Alaska Anchorage advanced to the NCAA Championship Game before falling to Lowell, marking the furthest advancement.

Seattle Pacific became the first GNAC team in 12 years to win the West Regional in 2000, and the Falcons advanced to the semifinal round of both the 2000 and '06 Elite Eights. SPU won its first regional in 1965, but was defeated by North Dakota at the quarterfinal stage. The Falcons have qualified for the NCAA playoffs 17 times, including 10 of the last 13 years. In 1995, '96, '98 and '99, they were regional runners-up.

In 2007 Springfield, Mass., will host the Elite Eight for the 18th time. Games will be played at the MassMutual Center March 21, 22 and 24, with the NCAA Championship Game televised live on the CBS Network.
