Great Northwest Athletic Conference History

The Great Northwest Athletic Conference is relatively new in name but it already holds a prominent position within the NCAA Division II arena. Formed in September of 2000 and entering its sixth season of championship play in 2005-6, the GNAC is comprised of nine members in four western states.

Three of the members—Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific—were charter members of the old Great Northwest Conference for men's basketball in 1982. The GNC merged with the women's Continental Divide Conference to form the Pacific West Conference in 1992. All nine GNAC members competed in the PacWest through the 2000-01 season. Montana State Billings will become the 10th team in 2007-08.

Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks and Seattle Pacific are longtime Division II members. Former NAIA programs Central Washington, Saint Martin's, Western Oregon and Western Washington joined in 1998. Northwest Nazarene and Seattle U. came aboard in 1999.

The multi-sport conference sponsors championship play in 14 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's track & field (indoor and outdoor) and women's volleyball. Men's basketball, women's basketball and women's volleyball feature full nine-team fields.

NCAA Division II Championships

The NCAA Division II Championships tournament was initiated in 1982 with 16 teams participating in the inaugural competition. After a play-in round in 1993-94, the NCAA officially expanded the tournament from 32 to 48 teams in 1995. Since 2003 the bracket has featured 64 teams. Eight teams advance to each of the eight regional tournaments, to be hosted by one of the top two seeds. Kearney, Nebraska, will host the Elite Eight for the first time in 2007.

Teams from the Great Northwest have regularly received playoff bids. In 2005, Seattle Pacific advanced to the national championship game and finished second. Previously, only Portland State (1995) appeared in a title contest.

The Falcons have qualified for NCAA postseason play 11 times, including a current run of 10 consecutive years (1997-06). They advanced to the Elite Eight in 1998, 2004 and 2005.

Cal Poly Pomona and North Dakota State each own five NCAA titles.
