Responsibilities:

- Either party may cancel this agreement without obligation to the other if cancellation notice is in writing at least 14 days before performance date.
- Performer(s) agrees to furnish payment to SPU for actual appearance preparation costs in the event of a late cancellation; late or non-appearance.
- Any additional accommodations or special requirements must be specified on this contract/attached rider.
- SPU requires the performer(s) to be solely responsible for payment of royalty fees and/or performance fees, fees required by unions and similar organizations, and similar costs.
- SPU requires the performer(s) to be responsible for compliance with this agreement and rule of any musicians' union in which the artist/provider of services participates.
- This agreement may not be assigned by either party without written permission of the other party.
- Sale of souvenirs, records and similar items may not be done in connection with the furnished service without written permission of SPU.
- SPU will not record or televise services without permission of performer(s), and will make a reasonable effort to prevent individuals from doing so.
- Performer(s) are responsible for their belongings. SPU is not responsible for performer(s) items that are lost, stolen or damaged.
- Any additional conditions must be submitted when returning this agreement. Additional conditions will be regarded as amendments to this agreement.

Liability:

Each party shall be responsible for its own liability arising from the acts or omissions of its employees, students, or agents occurring in the course of performing this agreement. Neither party agrees to assume any liability of the other, or to defend, indemnify, or hold harmless the other party, against any claims the other party, or liability of the other party, arising from the other party's performance of the agreement. Instead, all rights to indemnify and contribution between the parties to this agreement shall be provided by the law of the State of Washington.
