

Submission Disclosure and Agreement:

In submitting your play for consideration by Seattle Pacific University, you acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. Seattle Pacific University selects material, in its sole discretion, for publication from a pool of submitted material, and is in no way obligated to publish or consider your play. Seattle Pacific University will not publish or license your play without a signed Publishing Agreement between you and Seattle Pacific University.

2. You represent and warrant (a) that your play does not infringe upon any third party's copyright or other property or publicity right; (b) that if your play contains material from another source (ie. music or lyrics) that you have obtained proper permission for inclusion in your play; (c) that your play is original to, and was created and/or written solely by you; and (d) that your play is not libelous or unlawful.

4. You hereby agree to indemnify and hold Seattle Pacific University (and its agents) harmless from any and all claims, demands, costs, and liabilities that may arise in connection with a breach or repudiation by you of this Submission Disclosure and Agreement.

5. The playwright grants Seattle Pacific University non-exclusionary rights to publish their play. The playwright will retain all rights pertaining to the play. If the playwright chooses to submit his/her play to another publisher the playwright has the right to do so.
