

### Alumni Survey Background:

Bachelor degree recipients from 2009-10 were surveyed during spring quarter 2011 on a variety of questions, including job placement information. Alumni received an online survey and reminder messages and 29% responded.

*Note: An average response rate for this type of survey is 30%.*

#### Based on 2009-10 alumni

Of the survey respondents, 13% of the alumni are pursuing advanced degrees. Of those attending a graduate school, the majority (91%) stated that the education received from Seattle Pacific was “excellent/good” in preparing them for graduate school.
