### Introduction

In an effort to provide students with greater information to select certain academic programs for viability the US Department of Education mandated additional regulations for federal (Title IV) student aid eligible non-degree programs. These programs are called “gainful employment” programs; their primary task is to train students for specific gainful employment or occupations. In addition to annually reporting to the Department of Education on certain attributes of the program such as number enrolled, completed, and student loan amounts, schools are now required for each appropriate program to provide disclosure information, which this document supplies, about important features of the program such as on time completion rates, costs, job placement, and media debt levels.
