Liberal arts students wishing to pursue graduate accounting study can receive financial aid through the AICPA John L. Carey Scholarship Program. Scholarships are

available to all liberal arts degree holders of any regionally accredited US institution who wish to pursue a CPA certification.

Scholarships are given based on academic achievement, leadership and future career interests and are contingent upon

acceptance in a graduate accounting program. Each year, up to ten recipients will be awarded \$5,000 and will be eligible for renewal for one more year, provided satisfactory scholastic progress is maintained. Applications are available online at www.aicpa.org/members/div/career/edu/jlcs.htm.

quirement. Awards are available to both male and female students for all areas of post secondary study. A minimum GPA of 2.70 is required.

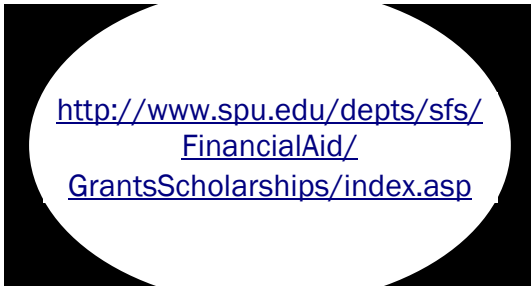
Criteria other than strictly academic ability and financial need are considered in the
