Candidates in the endorsement program interested in pursuing a Masters in Literacy would be advised to take **EDSE 5653**, **EDRD 5533** and/or **EDRD 5641**, and upon demonstrating outstanding academic ability in these courses can have them considered for application toward the Masters in Literacy Degree if students apply and are accepted into this graduate program (up to 6 credits total may apply). **EDRD 6506** is a required course in the Masters in Literacy Program and can fulfill Reading Endorsement as well as Masters in Literacy requirements.
