Dr. Collins' research program focuses on executive coaching and the use of technology to advance leadership development. Executive Coaching literature is nascent and lacks empirical research. Dr. Collins' RVT overall goal is to examining links between coaching practices and existing psychological frameworks and empirical research in an attempt to develop evidence-based approaches to executive coaching.

Current RVT project - Assessing and comparing coaching participant's (coachee) perceptions of their coaching relationship, post session mood, and their satisfaction with executive coaching delivered through two different modalities: eCoaching and face-to face.

Skills developed in this RVT include literature reviews, research methodology, statistical analysis, executive coaching, and research journal writing.
