

Research Assignment – Writing about Original Research General Psychology

This is an alternative to participating in experiments.

Articles

To receive extra credit, you must read a chapter from *Forty Studies that Changed Psychology: Explorations into the History of Psychological Research*, or 2) Annual Editions in Psychology 10/11 and write a two page paper summarizing the article (see below). Choose any chapter from *Forty Studies that Changed Psychology*. If you choose to read the Annual Editions of Psychology 10/11, you must pick from the following articles: #1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 21, 22, 23, 25, 28, 29, 32, 34, 36, 37, 40, 42 or 43,). Both texts will be on reserve in the library under General Psychology readings.

Your Paper

Your paper is to be two pages, typed, double-spaced, proofread summary of the article, ***including your own thoughts and reflections about the article***. Please use 12pt font and 1 inch margins. All writing is to be characterized by proper spelling, punctuation, grammar, and inclusive language (i.e., non-sexist).

Turing Your Paper in

Late Papers will not be accepted for extra credit. No assignments will be accepted over email. All papers must be turned in to the psychology department office in Marston Hall. Address the paper to Dr. Baine Craft. When submitting a paper, simply staple the pages. Do not place in a folder or binder. Do not include additional papers (such as a copy of the article) or title page.
