

Submitting Content to Course Lectures

To submit content, please bring it by the Instructional Technology Services office on the lower level of the SPU library. If you plan on submitting content regularly, we may be able to arrange for digital submission.

Please bring the following information with you:

- Course name and number. For example, *CHM 1211: General Chemistry I*. Does not need to be a current course.
- Name and title of instructor / presenter
- Title of lecture, presentation, or content
- Date of the recording (if available)
- Any other relevant information
