Demonstration Project: Possible Thesaurus, Keyword or text terms: **DE**: *animal foraging behavior; behavioral contrast; choice behavior; SU*: *risk; KW*: *rats; incentive contrast; foraging theory; Select a Field (optional)*: *risk sensitive; contrast; successive negative contrast*
Ethics Paper: Possible Thesaurus or Keyword terms: **DE**: *animal rights; animal welfare; animals; ethics; experimental ethics; bioethics; morality*
Possible Methodology limiters: *Clinical Case Study; Empirical Study; Literature Review; Treatment Outcome/Clinical Trial*
- [MEDLINE](#) via Ebscohost: indexing to the world's medical research literature
Demonstration Project: Possible **Select a Field (optional)** terms: *rats; successive negative contrast; incentive contrast; behavioral contrast; risk sensitive; foraging*
Ethics Paper: Possible **MeSH** terms: **MM** *animal experimentation; animal rights; animal welfare; bioethics; morals*
Possible Publication Type limiters: *Clinical Trial; Controlled Clinical Trial; Randomized Controlled Trial; Review*
- [Google Scholar](#): good for searching narrow topics that have specific terminology (use **Advanced Scholar Search** approaches)
Demonstration Project: *e.g. incentive contrast; daily energy budget rule; animal foraging behavior; rats*
Ethics Paper: *e.g. animal experimentation; animal rights; bioethics*
*Remember, when using Google Scholar off-campus, use SPU Library's link to get full text.
- [Biological Abstracts](#): (locate via **Article and Research Databases** link)
Demonstration Project: **MD** *foraging behavior* AND (**O** *rat* OR **Select a Field (optional)** *risk sensitive*)



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Obtaining Items:

- **Journals A-Z**: identifies which periodical titles SPU has full text online, in paper or microfilm
- **SPU Library**: resources on-site; books can be checked-out
- **Summit borrowing**: free 3-5 day delivery of **books** to Circulation counter for 6 week checkout
- **Interlibrary Loan (ILL)**: free (usually, or else up to \$15 per request). 1-2 week delivery.
Requesting ILL items from within PsycINFO and MEDLINE will autofill the request form.
- **Other Regional Libraries**: books can be checked out from all Summit participating libraries in Washington State and Oregon with your SPU ID and journals/databases can be used on-site

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
